### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

**Under the supervision of the Fire Captain, the Firefighter / Paramedic will be responsible for the following duties:**

- Performs emergency aid activities including administering first aid and providing other assistance as required
- Participates in fire drills, attends classes in firefighting, emergency medical, hazardous materials, and related subjects
- Operates radio and other communication equipment
- Participates in the inspection of buildings, hydrants, and other structures in fire prevention programs
- Maintains fire equipment, apparatus, and facilities. Performs minor repairs to department equipment
- Performs general maintenance work in the upkeep of fire facilities and equipment; cleans and washes walls and floors; cares for grounds and station; makes minor repairs; washes, hangs and dries hose; washes, cleans, polishes, maintains and tests apparatus and equipment
- Assists in development plans for special assignments such as emergency preparedness, hazardous communications, training programs, firefighting, hazardous materials, and emergency aid activities
- Presents programs to the community on safety, medical, and fire prevention topics
- Performs other related duties as required or assigned

## **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- A. Must be able to obtain BLS Provider CPR with Georgetown Fire
- B. Must provide a Driver's Record from DMV

- C. Must be able to pass a medical exam
- D. Must have High School Diploma or GED
- E. Must be 18 years or older at the time of application
- F. Must not have any felony convictions or disqualifying criminal history
- G. Must be eligible to work in the U.S.
- H. Preferred that candidate possess CSFM Firefighter 1 or have successfully completed a recognized fire recruit training academy or equivalent course

## **HOURS, WAGES AND BENEFITS:**

- The volunteer position does not include wages. Successful volunteers will be eligible for stipend shifts after completing a firefighter academy or other required onboard training
- Wages include department issued PPE, membership in the volunteer association including training, gear allowance, and camaraderie
- There is no guarantee of any paid employment of any kind in this position
