### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

**Under the supervision of the Fire Captain, the Firefighter / Paramedic will be responsible for the following duties:**

- Performs emergency aid activities including driving ambulances, administering first aid and providing other assistance as required
- Participates in fire drills, attends classes in firefighting, emergency medical, hazardous materials, and related subjects
- Operates radio and other communication equipment
- Participates in the inspection of buildings, hydrants, and other structures in fire prevention programs
- Maintains fire equipment, apparatus, and facilities. Performs minor repairs to department equipment
- Performs general maintenance work in the upkeep of fire facilities and equipment; cleans and washes walls and floors; cares for grounds and station; makes minor repairs; washes, hangs and dries hose; washes, cleans, polishes, maintains and tests apparatus and equipment
- Assists in development plans for special assignments such as emergency preparedness, hazardous communications, training programs, firefighting, hazardous materials, and emergency aid activities
- Presents programs to the community on safety, medical, and fire prevention topics
- Performs other related duties as required or assigned

## **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- A. Must have current Paramedic license
- B. Must have current BLS Provider CPR
- C. Must provide a Driver's Record from DMV

- D. Must be able to pass a medical exam
- E. Must have High School Diploma or GED
- F. Must be 21 years or older at the time of employment
- G. Must not have any felony convictions or disqualifying criminal history
- H. Must be eligible to work in the U.S.
- I. Must be able to complete service area #7 qualification provided by Georgetown Fire within 60 days of hire
- J. Preferred to have CSFM Driver / Operator 1A and 1B
- K. Preferred to be on the FCTC Statewide Eligibility List

- L. Preferred that candidate possess CSFM Firefighter 1 or have successfully completed a recognized fire recruit training academy or equivalent course
- M. Preferred to have a minimum of twenty-four (24) months experience in the last 60 months as a paid or volunteer firefighter with an active municipal fire department or fire protection district
- N. Preferred to Possess a valid Cal-JAC CPAT Card

## **HOURS, WAGES AND BENEFITS:**

- The candidate will work a 56-hour week schedule
- The starting wage for Firefighter / Paramedic is \$25.97 hour, approximately \$75,624.64
  - Includes 4 step wage increases at 4%
  - Longevity pay at 1% for every 5 years of employment at Georgetown FPD
- Georgetown FPD has a contract for wage increases as follows:
  - Fiscal Year 22/23 includes a 10% increase
  - Fiscal Year 23/24 includes a 7% increase
  - Fiscal Year 24/25 includes a 7% increase
